In the Adapted *It Takes Two to Talk®* Program, you learn practical and powerful strategies to help your child communicate and interact during everyday routines and activities. It is within these familiar, real-life interactions with you that your child's communication skills will grow.

- MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT FOR PROGRAM WILL BE 8 BOARD ELIGIBLE CHILDREN (MINIMUM OF 2 BOARD ELIGIBLE CHILDREN) AND MUST MEET CRITERIA FOR APPROPRIATENESS
- QUALIFYING FAMILIES WILL ALSO RECEIVE 2 (TWO) INDIVIDUALIZED IN-HOME CONSULTATIONS
- ♦ QUALIFYING FAMILIES MUST ATTEND ALL 4 (FOUR) INFORMATION SESSIONS. SESSION IS FOR PARENT ONLY. CHILD DOES NOT ATTEND THE ADAPTED IT TAKES TWO TO TALK® PROGRAM 4 DAY SERIES.
