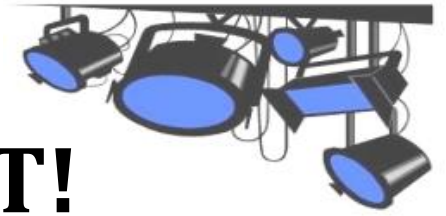




DSP SPOTLIGHT!
