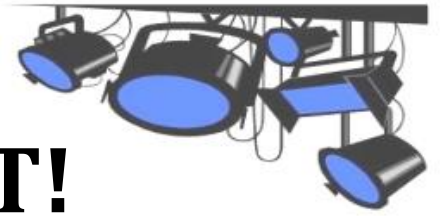




# DSP SPOTLIGHT!
