Those in attendance will learn about the variety of ways in which Remote Support, Assistive Technology, and Provider Software Technology can improve the lives of individuals with disabilities, and those who support them.

“With the staffing crisis we are facing right now, technology has become more important than ever,” said WCBDD Support Services Manager, Melissa Stall. “There is so much that technology can assist with to supplement the great work that in-person direct support professionals do.”
